**Two Bangor Boys
Back In Action;
John Hanley Wounded**

Word was received early last evening by Mr. and Mrs. Patrick Hanley of South Main Street, Bangor, in a telegram from the United States War Department that their son, Staff Sergeant John Hanley, of the United States Army was wounded in France on July 30. His wounds were reported as not serious.

Yesterday Mrs. Elizabeth DelBacco of North Fifth Street, Bangor, received word from the War Department that her husband, Pfc. Joseph Del Bacco of the U. S. Army, who was wounded in France late in June, returned to active duty with the armed forces on July 14.

Mrs. Lida Milazzo of North Sixth Street, Bangor, also received word that her husband, Pvt. James Milazzo of the U. S. Army, who was reported missing in action late in June in New Guinea, returned to active duty with the Army in June.
