## Lieut. Col. Edmond J. Buckley Back From Pacific War Front

Lieut. Colonel Edmond J. Buckley, U. S. Marine Corps, in private life executive vice-president of the Union Bank and Trust Company, arrived home on leave from strenuous campaigns in the Pacific theatre of war. Colonel Buckley arrived in the East yesterday and is now at his home with his family near Center Valley.

In the Marine Reserve at the outbreak of the war, it was but natural that the local banker should be called into service. Up to press time this afternoon Col. Buckley had not called on his business associates, who are happy over his safe arrival in his home community.

In addition to his rapid promotions, Col. Buckley has been cited on a number of occasions, the last coming on January 23 for outstanding performance of his duties in the Borgen Bay area, New Britain, a day after Christmas.

Mrs. Buckley is the former Miss Edna Caroline French of Llanerch. They have three children, Edmond J. Jr., Catherine and Robin David.
