Technical Sergeant Albert Mills was reported as slightly wounded in action in a telegram received by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Mills, 375 Fifteenth Avenue.

Sgt. Mills was awarded the Purple Heart. He was inducted June 13, 1942, and took part in the action on the Normandy beach on D-Day. A sister, Lt. Olive E. Mills, is in Italy.
