Private Roy L. Hoffert, stationed with the U. S. Army at Fort Knox, visited his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Roy Johnson, 818 North Hoffert Street, Fountain Hill, and his father, Lawrence Hoffert, 1539 East Fourth Street. When he was inducted into the service he stood six feet two and one-half inches in his stocking feet. When he got to New Cumberland he found a selectee there who measured six feet five and one-half inches in height.
