Sunday, April 8, at 10:45 a. m. a memorial service will be held for Pvt. Belford Miller in connection with the morning worship service at the First Baptist Church, 510 West Broad Street. The Rev. H. Frey pastor, will officiate. APR 6 1945

The pastor will speak on the theme, "A Great Price To Pay." Following the sermon, a gold star will be placed on the church service flag by Cpl. Samuel Engel. A gold star window flag will be presented to Mrs. Belford Miller by Robert Fox on behalf of the Young Men's Class, of which Belford was an active member before entering the service.

Linden V. Fisher will present the official United States flag to Mrs. Miller following which Mrs. Grace Beck will sing the last stanza of "The National Anthem."

Flowers will be provided by Mrs. Belford Miller and her daughter Sandra in memory of Pvt. Miller, and also by the Young Men's Class.

Members of the Harry F. Johnson Post, 379, American Legion, have been invited to attend the service.

Pvt. Miller was the first member of his church to be killed in action.
