Midshipman William Brunner Miller, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. T. Miller, this city, was among 1135 men commissioned as Ensigns, United States Naval Reserve, in ceremonies held today in the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, New York City. The group was the twenty-second class to be graduated from the oldest and largest Naval Reserve Training School, and brings the total number of graduates from the Training Center to approximately 20,000. Principal speaker at the ceremony was Rear Admiral D. C. Ramsey, USN, Chief of the Bureau of Aeronautics. Miller is a graduate of Moravian Preparatory School and attended Lehigh University from which he was transferred, by the Navy, to Mass. Institute of Technology where he majored in electrical engineering and communications. He enlisted in the Naval Reserve December 11, 1942. Ensign Miller will report for further training at Harvard University Cambridge, Mass.
