**John Verban
Killed in Italy
On October 16**

Pvt. John Verban was killed in Italy on October 16, according to a telegram received by his wife, Matilda, from the War Department. No further information was contained in the message.

Pvt. Verban entered the service on December 11, 1943 and received his training at Camp Blanding, Fla., and Fort Meade, Md. He arrived overseas on June 4 of this year.

Prior to entering the Army he was employed by the Prudential Insurance Company. He graduated from Allentown preparatory school and attended Dickinson University.

In addition to his wife, the daughter of Mrs. Joseph Borda of 510 Delaware Avenue, he is survived by an 18-months-old son, John Jr.; his mother, Mrs. Mary Verban of 429 East Fifth Street; a brother, Louis, and a sister, Vilma, at home.
