## Pfc. McNerney "Missing" Says War Dept.

Pfc. John A. McNerney, son of Mr. and Mrs. John McNerney, of 921 East Fourth Street, is reported missing in action since October 13, according to a telegram from the War Department, received by the parents on Saturday about 4:30 p. m.

A member of the 168th Infantry, Second Army Corps, 34th Division, he participated in the invasion of

Africa and the Tunisian campaign, and more recently with the U. S. combat forces in Italy.

A graduate of Bethlehem Catholic High School, he later attended Moravian College. At the time of his induction he was an employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.

He was inducted into the army on June 13, 1942, and received his basic training at Camp Meade, Md., and Camp Pickett, Va. The last letters received from him were dated October 9.
