Lt. Col. Kissner, Son Of Local Couple, To Head AMG Division

The appointment of Lieut. Col. Franklin H. Kissner, son of Mrs. James L. Kissner, 701 North New St., as deputy director of the Economics Division of the Office of Military Government for Germany, was announced in Berlin today.

The Economics Division, headed by Brig. Gen. William Draper Jr., is responsible for the formulation of plans and policies concerning the level of industrial production in Germany and the elimination of war potential from the German economy.

Col. Kissner is a graduate of Harvard University, class of 1930, and wears a Phi Beta Kappa key. In 1931, he won a Shelton Fellowship to Sorbonne University in Paris, and before entering military service, was managing accountant for the firm of Price, Waterhouse & Company, Inc., Pittsburgh.
