Pfc. Csrenko In Hospital At Hawaii

Pfc. Charles C. Csrenko, 22, son of Mrs. Julia Csrenko, of 744 Laufer Street, has been reported wounded in action, according to a telegram received by his mother from the War Department. The information states he is now in a hospital in Hawaii.

The young Marine entered the service on August 3, 1942, receiving his training at Parris Island and New River, N. C. He was then stationed at San Francisco, Calif., before being sent overseas to the Marshall Islands in February.

Prior to his enlistment in the Marine Corps, Pfc. Csrenko was employed by the Laros Textile Company. A brother, Third Class Petty Officer Joseph Csrenko, is stationed in Hawaii.

August 30, 1944
