### **Pacific War Veteran Home On Furlough**

A veteran of the Pacific Theater of Operations, Pfc. Francis Schnable, is spending a 30-day furlough at the home of his mother, Mrs. Mary Straub, 558 Broadway. Inducted June 13, 1942, he was assigned to the Military Police for a year and then was sent to Fort Knox, Ky., with a Tank Battalion. He served in France, Austria, Belgium and Germany. Pfc. Schnable holds the Purple Heart for wounds he received when four of his buddies were killed in a tank explosion. He is to report at Indiantown Gap for reassignment August 15.
