J. L. Conneen, Lehigh University, class of 1941, was advanced to the rank of Captain in the Army Air Corps, October 12. Captain Conneen entered the service at the reception center at Maxwell Field, Montgomery, Ala., early in October, 1941, having spent the summer in the employ of the P. B. & N. E. R. R. here in Bethlehem. He received his final training at Spence Field, Moultrie, Ga., where he graduated and received his pilot's wings and commission of 2nd Lieut. on May 20, 1942. On the same day he was married to Miss Jane Walker, of Montclair N. J. They have a seven-month-old daughter and are living at Bennettsville, S.
