### **Aerial-Gunner Home on Furlough**

S/Sgt. Robert K. Bieber, aerial-gunner on a B-24 Liberator, is home on a furlough after completing 35 missions over Germany.

Sgt. Bieber, son of Mr. and Mrs. T. I. Bieber, 75 Greenwich Street, entered the service in November 1943 and completed his basic training at Miami, Fla. He was sent to Kingman Field, Ariz., where he was awarded his gunner's wings; Lincoln, Neb.; El Paso, Tex., and an airfield in Kansas, before going overseas to Ireland 10 months ago.

The aerial gunner holds the Air Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, the Good Conduct Medal and the European Theater ribbon with two battle stars. Upon completion of his furlough, he will return to Santa Anna, Cal., for reassignment.
