BROTHERS TRANSFERRED

Mr. and Mrs. Linford Hillegas, 434 Cherokee Street, have been informed recently of the transfer of their two sons, Pfc. William Hillegas and Pvt. Walter Hillegas, to new scenes of action. Both are in the Army medical service.

William is now in Italy with a hospital unit. He left Sicily five weeks ago and just before removing

to the mainland of Italy ran across his cousin, James Hartung, who is serving in the infantry. Writing home, Bill told his family that "it's a grand feeling to meet someone from home away over here." He and Hartung are now about a mile apart, but have not met since reaching enemy shores.

Walter, who was in Hawaii from March 5 until about seven weeks ago, is stationed with the medical men in Australia. He came down with the measles just after landing but is OK now, his family says.
