Seriously Wounded



Pvt. William J. Bauer, son of Mr and Mrs. Alois Bauer, Nazareth R. D. 1, was reported seriously wounded in action in France, August 18, according to a telegram received by the parents dated September 4 from the government at Washington, D. C., and signed by the Adjutant General.

Young Bauer, who is 20 years old served in a tank division and has been in service since April, 1943. Under date of August 26 the parents received a letter from the Red Cross stating that their son is in an American hospital "somewhere in England," and is being treated for two burned hands.

Bauer has two other brothers in the service, both older than he. The eldest son and brother is Louis, who is a 2-c Petty Officer on a ship in service three years the 19th of this month; the second brother is Sebastian, who is in France and driving truck on convoy duty. He is in service since July, 1942.
