**Eugene Hoffman,
Quakertown,
Killed in France**

Private First Class D. Eugene Hoffman, 28, son of Mr. and Mrs. George W. Hoffman of 52 Penrose Street, Quakertown, who entered the armed forces in January, 1941, in order to accompany a life-long friend, Harold C. Moyer, was killed in action in France on July 29, according to word received in a War Department telegram by his parents.

Hoffman and his friend remained together for two years following their induction, and were parted when Moyer, a member of an infantry band, was sent to England. As far as is known, the two buddies never met again.
