Mrs. Hattie Wolfer, Nazareth R. D. 1, was informed by telegram from the Adjutant General's office in Washington, D. C., that her brother, Corp. Joseph J. Sakasitz, was wounded in action in the North African area on April 1. Corp. Sakasitz is a member of a Coast Artillery (A. A.) outfit and was with the local National Guard for a year previous to entering active service. Monday, Mrs. Wolfer received a letter from her brother which was written before he was wounded. He is the son of the late Frank and Hedwig Sakasitz of Nazareth and has been residing with Mrs. Wolfer.
