As Aviation Cadets

Seven Bethlehem boys were among the eleven from this area who were sworn in as aviation cadets yesterday in the Army Air Force Enlisted Reserve at the Allentown post office building.

They are George Libricz, 315 East Church Street; Elwood H. Bauder, 128 Washington Avenue; Raymond Gottschall, 535 East Laurel Street; John C. Craven, 908 Delaware Avenue; Paul C. Curatola, 941 Lawfer Avenue; John G. Sopko, 610 Hayes Street, and Raymond Salgado, Princeton Avenue. They were sworn in by Lt. Dewey Bardwell, president of the Aviation Cadet Examining board.

George Libricz, the only one of the group who has finished high school, is awaiting his eighteenth birthday to be called to active duty.
