Wounded In Action**

Mrs. Edward Rowe received a War Department telegram at her home, 808½ Evans Street, informing her that her husband, Pfc. Edward F. Rowe, had been slightly wounded in action in Germany December 11, 1944. The telegram further stated that reports of his condition will be forwarded as received.

Pfc. Rowe, overseas for the past four months, entered the service in March, 1944. He received his basic infantry training at Camp Blanding, Fla. JAN 5 1945
