**Pfc. Robert Strohl
Gets Army Discharge
After Service Overseas**

Bringing to a close his army career, Pfc. Robert R. Strohl, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles L. Strohl, 1403 Center Street, was honorably discharged from the service at the Hospital Center, Camp Buckner, N. C., with 60 discharge points.

A rifleman with the Third Infantry Division, he was removed from active duty December 16, 1944, for hospitalization. A veteran of 12 months duty in the European Theater of Operations, his decorations include the Combat Infantry Badge, Good Conduct Ribbon, Presidential Citation and the ETO Ribbon with three battle stars.

Before entering the service, the soldier was an inspector. His wife, Eleanore, resides at R. 60, Allentown.
