### Hellertown GI Freed From Prison

Mr. and Mrs. Steve Vasko, 1400 New Jersey Avenue, Hellertown, received word from their son, Pfc. Thomas J. Vasko, in a letter dated May 3, 1945, stating he had been liberated from a German prison camp, was well, and on his way home. Pfc. Vasko was previously reported missing in action in Germany, in a telegram received April 2nd.

In the Army since September 1942, he has seen 19 months overseas duty with the Field Artillery and two months with the Infantry, with whom he had been fighting at the time of his capture. He has also seen action in Italy and France. A brother, Pfc. John Vasko, is stationed at Camp Livingston.
