Pvt. James A. Medei, son of Mr. and Mrs. A. Medei, Bethlehem R. D. 4, was reported as slightly wounded in Germany in a War Department telegram received by his parents Armistice Day.

Pvt. Medei, 19, was inducted into the Army December 10, 1943, and received his training at Camp Grant, Ill., Camp Reynolds, Ky., and went overseas to England August, 1944. He served in the fighting in France and now Germany. Awarded the Purple Heart and the Oak Leaf cluster, he is recovering in a hospital somewhere in Germany.

Prior to his induction he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. His fiancée, Miss Mary Nemeth, resides at 938 Evans Street.
