the Army April 3, 1943, and after 13 weeks' basic training at Fort Lewis, Wash., was made a corporal. He also won an expert marksman medal. He spent two weeks at Idaho University with the Army, where he was one of 37 members of the "Rho Dammit Rho" fraternity, and played football there under Coach Francis Schmidt, former Ohio State University coach. While there he booted a 45-yard drop kick to win a game.
