Aboard USS Vincennes**

Charles N. Reed, Seaman 1/C, USNR, Route 3, served during the war aboard the USS Vincennes, whose crew is now performing one of its most pleasant tasks, that of bringing high-point Pacific veterans back home to the States.

Before being assigned to the "Magic Carpet Fleet", engaged in carrying veterans back from the Pacific, Reed's ship is credited with sinking a Jap cruiser in San Bernardino Straits, in one of the most unusual surface engagements of the war.
