Prior to entering the Naval Service, Ensign Edwards attended Lehigh University, Penn State College and Moravian College.

The last of August, he began preliminary training at the Naval Air Station, Philadelphia, and successfully completed the course early in November, before reporting to the "Annapolis of the Air" for intermediate training.

Having been designated a naval aviator, Ensign Edwards will go on active duty at one of the Navy's air operational training centers before being assigned to a combat zone.
