Warren L. Breinig, Jr., Promoted To Captain in Air Squadron

Warren L. Breinig, Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Warren L. Breinig, 22 West Centre St., Nazareth, a flight leader of a Fighter Squadron stationed at Orlando, Florida, was recently promoted to the rank of captain.

Captain Breinig was graduated from Nazareth High School in 1935 and from Lafayette College in 1941 with a degree in chemical engineering. Upon graduation from college, Captain Breinig was employed at Bethlehem Steel Corporation's plant at Sparrow's point, Maryland.

Captain Breinig's engineering career was interrupted by enlisting as a cadet in January, 1942. He received his commission in October of the same year.

It was Captain Breinig who flew "The Borough of Nazareth" fighter plane while at a Florida flying field, following Nazareth's "Buy-a-Plane" bond campaign.
