**"Missing" Soldier
Believed Prisoner**

Pfc. Harold J. Parry, son of Mr. and Mrs. Arthur A. Parry Jr., Slatington, a former Bethlehem Steel Company employe, who was listed two weeks ago by the War Department as "missing in action" in North Africa, is believed to be a prisoner of Germany.

Hopes for their son's safety have been strengthened as a result of informatoin conveyed to them over the weekend by Roland Griffith, Walnut Street, Slatington, who said he had heard Private Parry speak over a short-wave broadcast originating in Germany Saturday night and that two unidentified Allentown soldiers transmitted messages as well as the Slatington man. The messages were similar, stating that the person was well and would write as soon as possible. They also stated that the men were being sent to a prison camp in Germany.
