WASHINGTON, D. C.—The War Department announces the appointment of Miss Corinne Elizabeth Conant, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. F. C. Conant, 314 Hamilton Avenue, Bethlehem, as a physical therapy aide in the Medical Department of the Army with the relative rank of second lieutenant. She completed her training for this work at Valley Forge General Hospital, Phoenixville.

She will be assigned to duty with the Army in hospitals in either this country or overseas. Many of the patients she will treat will be war wounded, evacuated from overseas. Many of the soldiers suffering from amputations, fractures, burns and nerve injuries require treatment by physical therapy consisting of exercise, massage and various forms of heat and electricity, which supplement medicine and surgery to effect the cure.
