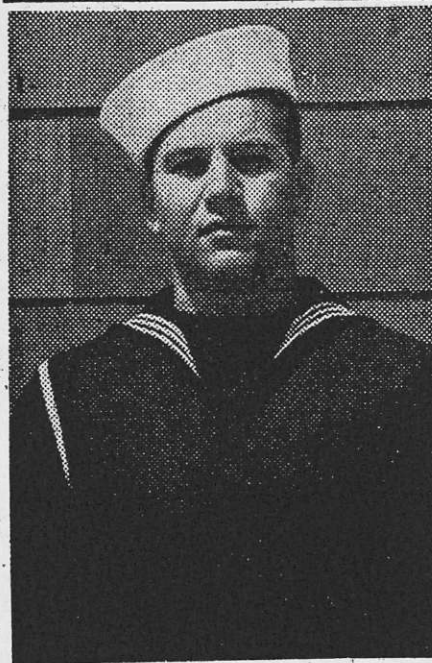


Pasternak, Tony
