Board Gets New Order

DRAFT BOARDS GET NEW OR

McNutt Defers All Medical, Dental, Veterinary and Engineering Students.

Washington, Dec. 18 (INS).—Draft boards throughout the country to-day were under order of Manpower Chiel Paul V. McNutt to defer un-til the end of the present semester, March 1, 1943, all medical, dental, veteringer and engineering students, veterinary and engineering students who have completed at least one

yeat of study. The order was issued after the Army and Navy announced that qualified youths in the armed forces would be sent to college to con-tinue their education.

The annuncement said that re-sources of the nation's colleges and sources of the hatton's conleges and universities will be utilized to "maintain a steady flow of young men suitable for specialized edu-cational technical training." (Continued from Page 1) of a selected number of colleges and universities "to maintain a steady flow of young men suitable for specialized educational technical training."

It was estimated that the num-ber of men so detailed would num-ber 250,000. They will attend the institutions in uniform and on military pay.

The educational program was a result of the recent amendment to the Selective Service and training act which reduced the draft age to 18 years and eliminated "the prin-cipal source of men college stu-dents."

Secretary of War Stimson said that the program will temporarily destroy liberal education in Amer-ica, but he added that he did not thnk it would have a permanently bad effect.
