HEADQUARTERS, PANAMA CANAL DEPT. — Brig. Gen. Francis P. Hardaway has presented an Army diploma to Pvt. Stanley Smolsky, of 1449 E. 6th St., Bethlehem, Pa., upon his graduation from the enlisted division of the Panama Coast Artillery Command Training Center.

Pvt. Smolsky completed a 16 week course qualifying him as a telephone and telegraph wire chief. He was temporarily away from duty with Lt. Col. Frederick L. Van Atta's anti-aircraft automatic weapons battalion. He has served with the Coast Artillery forces in Panama since March 6, 1943.
