Wounded in Action



A telegram from the War Department received by A. Cmorey of 805 Hayes Street, informed him that his son, Sergeant Andrew E. Cmorey, had been slightly wounded in action in France, August 28.

Sgt. Cmorey enlisted in the Army in 1939 and since that time has never been home on a furlough. He received the Purple Heart last April for wounds received in the Sicilian campaign. The young soldier has taken part in the action around the Hawaiian Islands, Casablanca, Tunisia, Sicily and France.

Prior to enlisting Cmorey was a pupil at the Bethlehem Technical High School.

September 27, 1944
