T/5 Henry R. Kresh On 30-Day Furlough

T/5 Henry R. Kresh is spending a 30-day furlough with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Henry Kresh, 215 Seventh Avenue, after serving with the Quartermaster Corps overseas in France since August 1944.

T/5 Kresh was inducted November 5, 1942, and received his training in the States before going overseas to England last summer. He wears the Good Conduct Medal and four battle stars on his ETO ribbon. His brother, Pfc. Richard Kresh is awaiting shipment to the States from France. The boys met overseas about five months ago.
