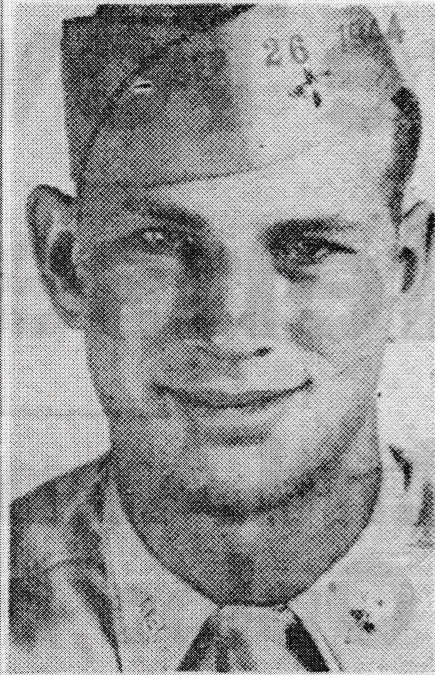


Riley, Charles E.
