**TROPHY IN DEAD SEAMAN'S
MEMORY IS ON DISPLAY**

A trophy 20 inches in height with a bronze pigeon perched on the top, displayed in the window of John Albert's store, Bangor, is on display in honor of Blaine E. Reimel, U. S. Navy, who was killed in action in the Pacific.

The trophy which is given by the Bangor Association of Racing Pigeon Clubs, was won by Reimel, last Fall. The trophy has to be won three times in succession by a member to retain possession and Reimel has one leg of the trophy now.
