Private First Class Walter King, 19-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Wilmer King, Easton R. D. 4, who was previously reported wounded in action September 13, 1944, in France, is now listed as missing in action in Belgium since January 1, 1945. Prior to entering the service on November 13, 1943, he was employed by the Pep Boys here. Pfc. King trained at infantry camps in South Carolina and Maryland before embarking overseas in May, 1944. His parents received letters dated nine days before he was reported missing, acknowledging receipt of his Christmas gifts.
