Second Lieutenant Catherine Miller, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Miller, 450 South New Street, is serving as staff nurse with the 34th Station Hospital, a Mediterranean theater unit which has aided about 12,000 wounded and sick soldiers to recovery in 21 months of operation overseas.

This hospital was commended by Brigadier General Strickland, then military governor of Pantelleria, Italy, for its work there. Moving to Palermo, Sicily, the hospital received a commendation from Brigadier General Hobart Gay, then a patient.

Overseas 21 months, Lt. Miller wears the Mediterranean Theater Ribbon with two battle participation stars. She was formerly employed at the Women's Hospital, New York City.
