Sgt. Joseph E. Beil Receives Discharge

S/Sgt. Joseph E. Beil, U. S. Army, son of Mr. and Mrs. Paul D. Beil, 216 West High Street, received his honorable discharge from the Army at Indiantown Gap November 1.

Sgt. Beil returned from overseas duty last Saturday after spending two years in England, France, Belgium, Holland and Germany. He served with the **Nov 10 1945** Second Infantry Division.

Wounded twice, Sgt. Beil wears the Purple Heart with two clusters, a Unit Citation ribbon, and five battle stars.

Before his induction in April, 1943, Sgt. Beil was employed at Ortwein's Cafe, and was a former employe of the Sure-Fit Company.
