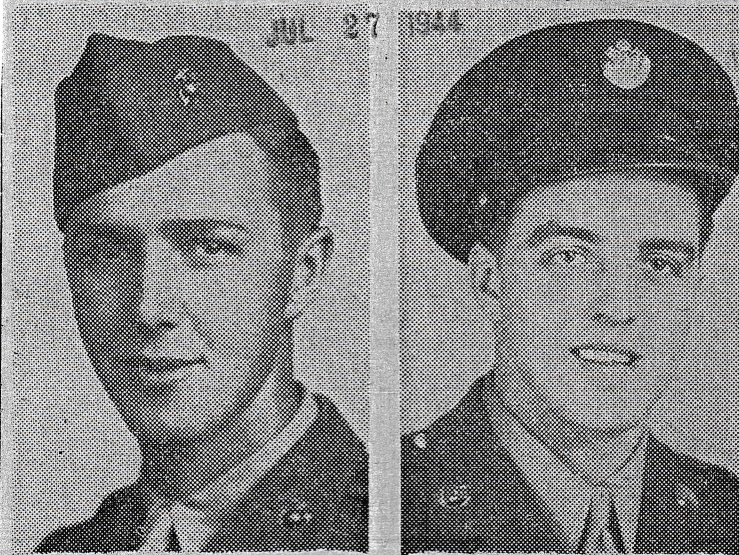

Brothers Get Promotions

Two sons of Mr. and Mrs. Edwin Schnecker of 316 East Fifth Street recently received promotions while serving in the armed forces of the nation.

Edward, who enlisted in the U. S. Marine Corps on February 28, 1943, received his basic training at Parris Island, N. C. He was then stationed at New River, N. C., later being transferred to Wright Junior College at Chicago to study Radar and Radio. He also completed a course at the Utah State Agricultural College after which he was stationed at Corpus Christi, Texas. He won his present rank of Staff Sergeant at the age of 18 and is presently located at Cherry Point, N. C.

His brother, Robert, was inducted into the Army in November, 1943, receiving his basic training at Camp McIellan, Alabama. After a short while at Ft. Meade, Md., he was shipped to North Africa and from there to Italy where he is now stationed. He has been promoted from the rank of Private to that of Private First Class.
