Sgt. William P. Stofko, now serving in Derdingen, Germany with his famed 100 "Century" Division, Company A, 399th Infantry, was promoted to the grade of Staff Sergeant.

The 20-year-old infantryman is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Stofko, 709 Atlantic Street. He attended St. Cyril and Methodius parochial school, Broughal Junior High School and Liberty High School and is a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.

The new staff sergeant was recently cited with the Bronze Star. He hopes to remain with his outfit, but his promotion makes him eligible for discharge under the Army's new point system.
