An original member of the Navy's first commissioned vessel of her type, he took part in the landings at Bizerte and Tunisia, Africa; Sicily, Salerno, Anzio, Normandy and had been in the supply service between England and France until his return to this country. Twenty-four years of age, he is the oldest of four brothers who enlisted as a group shortly after Pearl Harbor.
