### War Department Telegrams Reveal Cousins Are Casualties

Advices received from the War Department by their families today indicate that two local boys—cousins—are battle casualties. Pvt. Carl Gibson has been reported killed in France and Pfc. Paul Gibson is carried on the "missing" list following his participation in action on the Belgian battlefield.

Pvt. Carl V. Gibson is a cousin of Mrs. Emory B. Surber, 410 Wood-

lawn Avenue. He is survived by his wife and two-year-old son, two brothers and two sisters. Two of his brothers are serving in camps in England and California.

Mrs. Surber's brother, Pfc. Paul Gibson, served with a medical branch of the 394th Infantry Division in Belgium. His parents reside in Princeton, West Va., and his wife in Washington, D. C.
