Navy Man Back From 25 Months Of Foreign Duty

James L. Broughal Jr., Aviation Radioman 2/C, USNR, of 742 Pawnee Street, has returned from a 25-month tour of duty in the Atlantic where he served as radioman gunner of one of the Navy's land-based Liberator search planes on numerous combat patrols.

The 31-year-old Bethlehem airman's group comprised one of five squadrons operating as front line units of Fleet Air Wing Seven. The five groups sank 14 Nazi U-boats, probably destroyed two others and damaged 16.

A graduate of Bethlehem High School, Broughal entered the Navy in February, 1942. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. L. Broughal, reside at the Bethlehem address.
