## Killed in Action

A War Department telegram was received by Mrs. Mildred Hagenbuch, 32 Park Street, Nazareth, yesterday, stating that her husband Pfc. George L. Hagenbuch, was killed in action February 25 in Germany. The telegram stated that a letter would follow. Pfc. Hagenbuch, who was serving with the Third Army as a machine gunner on a tank, entered the service in May, 1944, and was stationed at New Cumberland, Pa., Camp Croft, S. C., and Camp McCoy, Wis., before going overseas in November, 1944. Pfc. Hagenbuch, who was 32 years of age last May 29, is survived by his wife, the former Mildred Edelman; three children, Joan, 10; George, Jr., 9; Kathleen, 8 months; his mother, Mrs. Sadie Hagenbuch, Nazareth, and a sister, Mrs. Stephen Mayrosh, of Easton.
