Cpl. E. M. Faust Wounded In Italy Warfare

Corporal Edwin M. Faust, husband of Virginia Felker Faust, 16 East Ettwein Street, Bethlehem, is recovering in a base hospital in the Mediterranean theater of operations from wounds suffered in Italy several weeks ago.

Cpl. Faust has been in army service a year and a half and has been overseas the past six months. He received his training at Fort Meade and later at Camp Shenango, Pa.

Word of Cpl. Faust's wounding was received here by his wife early this month. The War Department stated he had been victim of a delayed action bomb in the vicinity of Naples and suffered contusions of the right thigh. The latest report was that he was improving satisfactorily.
