## Soldier Hurt On Way Home With Discharge

DEC 27 1945

Corporal Thomas Weaver, Allentown R. 60, enroute to his home last evening following his discharge at Indiantown Gap yesterday after three years of service, suffered contusions of his body in an accident in the 600 block of Broadway. A passing motorist took him to St. Luke's Hospital for treatment.

Some time after he and a number of G.I.'s received their honorable discharge, he drove one of his buddies to Easton. While headed for home, the machine skidded on ice while travelling eastward on Broadway, causing the car to hit a service pole and a tree, the impact turning the vehicle around. The right front side and rear of the machine, was damaged to some extent. It was towed to a garage. Officers Edward Cottage and Michael Filaseta investigated.
