Mother Gets Son's Posthumous Medal

Mrs. Anna Munjone, 603 North Sixth Street, Allentown, yesterday received from the War Department the posthumous award of the Purple Heart medal and the certificate attesting to the gallantry in action of her son, Private First Class Arthur P. Munjone, 19, who was killed July 3 in the North African area.

Private Munjone, whose father, James Munjone, died July 4, 1936, enlisted in the Army Air Forces when he was 17 and after serving at various Army airfields in the United States was sent overseas and took part in the battle of Tunisia last February.

Allentown-born, he was a graduate of the Allentown High School, 1936, and worked for a short time as waiter in Walp's Restaurant before entering the armed forces. Besides his mother, there are five brothers and sisters in Allentown, Vincent, Paul, Ernest, Catherine and Irene.
