Bethlehem Woman Advised Son is Missing in Action

Word has been received by Mrs. R. S. Shaw, former resident of Stroudsburg, now residing in Bethlehem, that her son, Technical Sergeant William R. Brown is reported missing in action in an Army Air Force raid on Germany.

The East Stroudsburg High School student left here with Company G, 109th Infantry in January, 1941. Later he transferred to the regular Army Air Corps while in training at Indiantown Gap.

He received training as an airplane mechanic at Jefferson Barracks, Mo., and after more extensive training at Chanute Field, Ill., was assigned to Las Vegas, Nev., as an instructor in machine gun and mechanics.
