Writer Praises Nazareth Soldier.

Ivan H. (Cy) Peterman, noted Philadelphia Inquirer war correspondent writing in his daily column in Tuesday's issue in describing how the American soldiers take their wounds chin-up, says this:

"I think Joe Sakasits is one of the worst wounded men I've seen come out of battle and still live. Joe lives in Nazareth, Pa., and was run over by a tank at El Guitar. He was in the hospital the same time I was

there and was given me as exhibit A on "How much can happen to you and still not kill."

Corporal Sakasits is now back in America and is at Walter Reed Hospital in Washington, D. C. His parents live at the Penn Allen, half way between Bath and Nazareth.
