Gets Bronz Medal For Okinawa Heroism

Pfc. Edward P. Shively, of this city, has been awarded the Bronze Star medal for heroic service on Okinawa.

In making the award, Maj. Gen. J. L. Bradley, commanding the 96th Division, cited Shively for his courage when he volunteered to rescue a wounded comrade from an area under heavy enemy fire.

A veteran of the Leyte campaign before landing with Tenth Army assault troops on Okinawa, Shively is a member of Company B, 383rd Infantry Regiment.

The son of Roland Shively, 214 Hesperus Street, this city, he was a truck drvier for Del Grosso, of this city, before entering the Army.
